Welcome!!!

In class you will learn the Judy Niemeyer technique of paper piecing and you will learn curved piecing with some great tips and tricks to make it easier than ever.

Fabric Requirements

Please refer to the pattern for the necessary fabric amounts needed to complete the table runner. Or

7/8 yd. - Fabric #1 - Outer layer spike background

1/3 yd. - Fabric #2 - Outer layer center spike

1/3 yd. - Fabric #3 - Outer layer spike #2. 1/3 yd. - Fabric #4 - Outer layer spike #3. 1/3 yd. - Fabric #5 - Center background 1/3 yd. - Fabric #6 - Center spikes

1/3 yd - Fabric #7 – Setting triangles 1 1/2 yd. Backing and binding.

General Supply List

Cactus Flower pattern by Judy Niemeyer, Available from the instructor - \$28 (Pattern contains enough papers for 3 table runners)
Basic sewing supplies
Sewing Machine in good working order

Medium or large cutting mat

45mm or 60 mm Rotary cutter with new blade, this is very important, you will be cutting through many layers of fabric at once!!

6x12 ruler and/or 6x24

Small scissors

Seam ripper

Good quality thread

Highlighter markers, at least 2 colors

Paper Piecing Supplies

12" Add-A-Quarter Ruler

Heavy Template Plastic, at least a 4" x 12" piece Scotch Tape

Glue stick

Flower pins

3 - 1gallon size ziplock type bags

Stapler and staple remover

Purple Thang or stiletto

Binder clips

Large paper clips

Glue pen (Avery, Sew Line, Fons & Porter will all work)

Pre-class Instructions

Please read through your instructions. This will help familiarize yourself with the terminology that I will be using.

If you have made a Judy Niemeyer pattern before and are comfortable with cutting your fabric please have your fabric cut and ready for class.

If this is your first time working on a Judy Niemeyer pattern, please do the following pre class instructions. This will give you more time in class for the important stuff like sewing.

If you have access to the internet, go to YouTube.com and do a search for cutting foundation papers and you will find one with Judy Niemeyer cutting the foundation papers.

One thing that Judy forgets to mention is that when you are stacking your papers make sure that they are all the same papers.

When picking out your fabrics be sure that there is a good **contrast** between your spikes and backgrounds, otherwise your spikes will be lost.

Please label 3 large ziplock type bags #1-3.

Cutting

Fabric #1

Cut (2) 9"x42" strips. Sub cut (8) 7"x9" rectangles. Place into bag #1. Cut (2) 5 1/4" x 42" strips. Sub cut into (8) 5 1/4"x8 1/4" rectangles. Place into bag #1.

Fabric #2

Cut (1) strip 7 3/4"x42". Sub cut into (4) 7 3/4"x8 1/2" rectangles. Put into bag #1.

Fabric #3

Cut (2) strips 5 3/4"x 42. Sub cut into (4) 5 3/4"x 13 1/2" rectangles. Add these to your bag #1.

Fabric #4

Cut (1) strips 6 3/4" x 42". Sub cut into (4) 6 3/4"x 10" rectangles. Add these to your bag #1.

Fabric #5

Cut (2) strips 4 1/4" x 42". Sub cut into (8) 4 1/4"x 10" rectangles. Place these in bag#2.

Fabric #6

Cut (2) strips 3 1/2"x 42". Sub cut into (48) 1 1/2"x 3 1/2" rectangles. Place these in bag #2.

Fabric #7

Cut (1) strip 9 3/4"x42". Sub cut into (4) 9 3/4"x9 3/4" squares. Place in bag #3.

Fabric #2 CS-1 Spike 1/3 yd


Fabric #6 Unit-M Spike 1/3 yd

Fabric #3 CS-3 Spike 1/3 yd


Fabric #7 Template #1 Background 1/3 yd

Fabric #4 CS-5 Spike 1/3 yd
