Class Supply List

Sewing Machine – In good working order (Unless provided at the venue). We will be using straight and zigzag stitches along with free-motion quilting. Please make sure your machine is capable of handling those things and please know how to operate your machine for those stitches and for free-motion before class/workshop. We will not have time in class/workshop to go over each student’s machine.

Fabric – 2 (two) – ½ yard pieces of muslin (bleached or unbleached) to use as a foundation.

Batting – ½ yard cotton

Thread 1) 50wt cotton for piecing and quilting 2) monofilament (I recommend Monopoly by Superior) for appliqué 3) any specialty threads (metallics, rayons, silks, etc.) for adding decorative touches.

Needles – Top Stitch 80/12 and 90/14

Iron and Ironing Board – A small travel iron and tabletop ironing board UNLESS irons and boards will be available at the class/workshop venue. Please check with the person/s in charge.

Safety pins and straight pins – for stabilizing layers for quilt “sandwiches”

Fabric Scissors for cutting shapes from fabrics

Small Scissors for clipping threads

Rotary cutter, cutting mat and acrylic ruler - A 6” x 24” will do just fine.

Notebook and pencil/pen
