

Collage Quilt Supply List

Important: Sign up for the collagequilter.com newsletter to receive the free “mushroom” pattern for this class.

-Mini Wand Iron. Clover is an example, also check Amazon. Don't worry if you do not have one, we will be sharing these so we don't overwhelm the power in the room.

-Ribbed Silicone Heat Resistant Mat, I prefer ribbed so the iron does not roll around)

-Fine Point Tweezers

-6” Karen Kay Buckley or Tim Holtz's serrated scissors

-Mechanical Pencil

-Parchment Baking Paper (no smaller than 18x20)

-11 x 14 x 1/8 Foam Board covered with batting & taped down on back or 11 x 14 wool mat or larger

Fat Quarter for background fabric (cream or beige subtle print)

Prepared Fabric fused with LITE STEAM A SEAM2:

A wide selection and assortment no larger than a 5” square in the colors you choose, or the following colors in values of light, medium & dark for each:

Red (8-10); Cream (6-10); Beige (3-5); White (3-5); Green (3-5)

AVOID stripes, dots, large scale prints & solids.

Go through your stash! I will have small packets of fused fabric to purchase (\$5) that will be enough to complete this project.

Optional:

*\$35/ (To be ordered in advance)

8 piece kit (includes parchment paper, fine point tweezers, Tim Holtz's scissors, mechanical pencil, curated ready to use fused fabric, silicone heat resistant pad, corsage pin and 11x14 foam board covered with batting).
