NATALIE BARNES: "Rotary Cutting: No Rule(r)s"

SUPPLY LIST

Sewing machine and manual

Full size sewing scissors and small scissors

Small cutting mat and strip ruler along with small ruler of your choice

Rotary cutter with new blades (45 or 28mm)

Piecing threads in neutral grey, 2-4 loaded bobbins of the same thread

Pens, notebook, Camera!

FABRICS:

A shoebox size container of little scraps, 3" or smaller including landscape or conversation prints that touch your heart

A "tub "or" shallow container" of small, medium and large prints varying in value and color (These can be large scraps.)

The equivalent of 24 fat quarters or more including some long strips or quarter yard pieces

A small stack of small/medium textures in a neutral background color – all light values(These can be large scraps.)

The equivalent of 12 fat quarters or more including some long strips or quarter yard pieces

This is a working techniques class. We are not making a quilt. We are honing our techniques, so select your fabrics accordingly.
