NOTES:

The edge and corner “rings” require a little more fabric than the interior rings. Therefore, you may use a jellyroll ONLY IF it contains 2 strips of each fabric.

Respect for the “scant ¼ inch” is always helpful! What's that? Give me a call and I'll explain a simple test for this.

- Rotary mat, cutter and ruler for cutting strips and subcutting pieces.
- Sewing Machine (cleaned, oiled, new needle, manual)
- 1/4-inch Foot.
- Matching thread for sewing.
- Thin straight pins and 2 safety pins.
- Two 1-gallon zip lock bags for organizing pieces.
- A whole section of the newspaper (I'll bring some, too).
