Supply List

Each umbrellas is sewn and then appliquéed on top of a block of four beach towels (with sand in-between them)

Quilt finishes at 31" h x 39" w)

Fabrics:

Umbrella fabrics

Less than 1/8 yard of fabric per umbrella, for just under 2 yards total for the 15 umbrellas. Striped fabrics are encouraged, or more than one fabric per umbrella if/when not using stripes

Towels fabrics – an opportunity to use your scraps!

60 pieces of colorful fabrics cut 2-1/2" x 4-1/2"

Dry sand fabric

1/2 yard (or 3/4 yard if to be used for binding as well)

Wet sand fabric - 1 piece cut 2" x 39"

Foam - 1 piece cut 1" x 39" of white-ish fabric

Water - 1 piece cut 4-1/2" x 39" of blue fabric

Bleached muslin

3/4 yard (for the underside of each umbrella and the center of each towel/sand block, underneath the umbrella)

One yard of fabric for the back of the quilt

Less than a third of a yard of fabric for the binding for the quilt

Supplies:

Thread with which to quilt the piece

Invisible/clear thread (for machine appliquéing the umbrellas to the blocks)

Iron and ironing board or pad

Sewing machine in good working order

Any other supplies you usually use while sewing, including ideally:

45mm rotary cutter

6" x 12" and 6" x 24" rotary cutter rulers

Rotary cutting mat

And to finish the project, you'll need about a yard of batting
